Philip Krawitz, the owner of Cape Union Mart, Old Khaki, Poetry and K-Way, is a proud supporter of South African Zionist organisations. Krawitz donates substantial funds, from the profits of Cape Union Mart - the money of hard-working, freedom-loving South Africans - to the Israeli apartheid regime.

In 2015, Krawitz received the Yakir Keren Hayesod award for raising the largest amount of funds per capita for the occupying Israeli apartheid regime. These funds were used during the 2014 'Protective Edge' massacre on Gaza, murdering 2 251 Palestinian civilians - ordinary people.

SINCE 7 OCT 2023, APARTHEID ISRAEL HAS:

- Murdered over 24 810 people, 75% of which are children and women
 Deliberate targeting of civilians is a war crime
- Denied and deprived Gaza of food, water, medication and fuel, multiple violations of international humanitarian law. Starvation is a weapon of war used by Israel
- Attacked and invaded Gaza's largest hospital, killing and injuring patients and healthcare workers, a violation of international humanitarian law
- Bombed Gaza's oldest church, Saint Porphyrius Church, and killed at least 18 people, including several children
- Bombed over 253 schools, and 11 universities
- Killed nearly 118 journalists
- Killed 362 Palestinians in the West Bank, at least 95 of whom are children
- Killed more than 337 healthcare workers
- Relentlessly, viciously and in full view of the world, committed the crime of apartheid under international law.

2023: As of 24 November, more than 70% of homes in Gaza have been damaged or destroyed by the Israeli Occupation Force. Churches, mosques, hospitals and schools sheltering civilians have also been bombed.

Since 7 October over 24 448 Palestinians were murdered by Israeli bombings in Gaza, including over 10 600 children. Almost 8 000 people are unaccounted for.

Over 60 000 people have been severely injured and cannot be adequately treated because Israel has bombed all of Gaza's hospitals, deliberately killed medical staff, and blocked medical supplies from entering the area. Hundreds of children have had to have their limbs amputated without anesthesia.
