PSA YL, E4H & SA BDS COALITION LIST OF APARTHEID-FREE DATES

As the holy month of Ramadaan dawns upon Muslims, the PSA YL, E4H and the SA BDS Coalition urge you to refrain from breaking your fast with dates affiliated with Apartheid Israel. 75% of Medjool dates are produced in "Israel" and the Medjool dates industry depends on sales in Ramadaan. Here are a few tips when shopping for dates:

- Always check the label on the box when purchasing dates.
- Don't buy dates that are produced in Israel or on occupied land in the West Bank.
- If no country or region of origin is found on the box, check the company website for the country of origin.
- Remember, one of Israel's largest date exporters is Hadiklaim. If the box says "exported by Hadiklaim" then please do not purchase these dates.

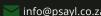
